Jack Killy, star of stage, radio and television, will be guest singer with the Rochester "Women's Choral Club" at their special concert on May 26 at Woodlawn Baptist Church.

Born in Somerville, Mass., Killy was hailed as the "radio discovery of 1953" as a result, the "boy baritone" wound up with a scholarship at the Juillard School.

**TO GAIN EXPERIENCE** he got into a few musical comedies and, proving the quirk of show business, became one of the top skaters at the New York City Center ice show, where he sang the leading role opposite Sonja Henie in "It Happened on Ice."

He capped the part of "Curly" in the Theatre Guild's "Oklahoma," then time out for a Navy war service in the Navy, where he headed a number of service shows.
