The coronation and coronation of Elizabeth II as Queen of England was a once-in-a-lifetime event, given tremendous coverage on TV by General Motors Co.

THE CATHOLIC RITUAL that made up much of the ceremony recognition, anointing, coronation—all were a part of our recent episcopal consecration in the Rochester diocese. Promises made by the Queen in answer to the archbishop followed a formula close to that of Bishop Casey's responses to Cardinal Spellman. Reception of the scepter, ring and crown followed the same ancient pattern by which the bishop received his crozier, ring and mitre.

The solemn and secret anointing with oil and the seating of the sovereign upon the throne of state, both had their counterparts in the consecration of our Auxiliary Bishop.

It was an awesome and unforgettable sight, with precious jewels and resplendent robes and priceless robes. THEY MISSED THE BOAT on only a few points. That choir of British prelates in black and white surplices would have been a treasure chest of its own in the episcopal robes of the Catholic Faith of old.
