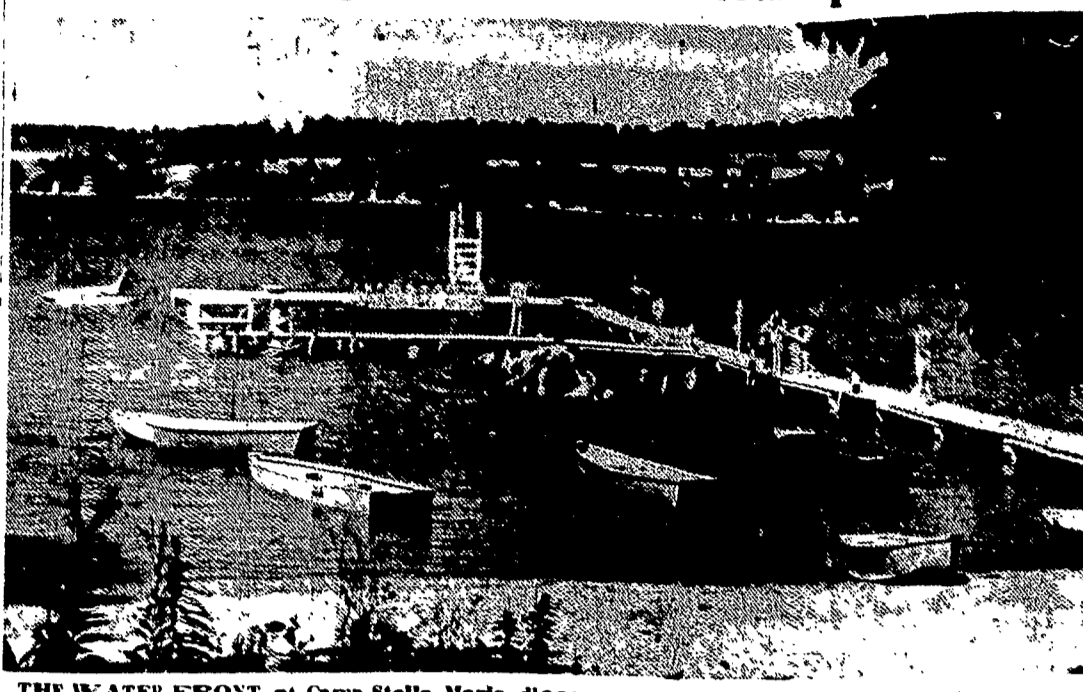

Red Cross Opens Swim Program

Ninth annual swimming program, conducted by Rochester Chapter, American Red Cross, for children in Monroe County outside the city of Rochester opened Monday, July 6, and will continue through Friday, August 14, according to Dr. James H. Reid, Chairman of Water Safety Program in Rochester Red Cross Chapter.

About 1500 youngsters in the county are registered for instruction in swimming, at five swimming sites, which will serve about 15 communities. This program will involve the volunteer services of more than 130 volunteer instructors, motor service drivers, supervisors, and registrars (the latter are volunteers from the individual branches where the program is being conducted). Youngsters between the ages of 8 and 15 years are included in this branch swimming program.

Lessons will be given at Peter's Pool in Greece, Meridian Ponds Pool, State Teachers College Pool, Brockport; Webster Park Pool, and Genesee Valley Park Pool.
