miration and imitation of generations to come." THE CARDINAL'S eulogy recalled the bitter contest of almost two decades Pope Leo had with Germany's Prime Minister Bismark and the Kulturkampf. The Cardinal wrote: "The aggression and high pretensions of the Prime Minister were met with the moderation and firmness of an enlightened Pontiff. Those were the weapons which were measured against the power and prestige of a mighty empire. . . . In the year 1868, the Kulturkampf, monument of a great man's folly fell, and he (Bismark) himself was buried beneath the ruins."
