

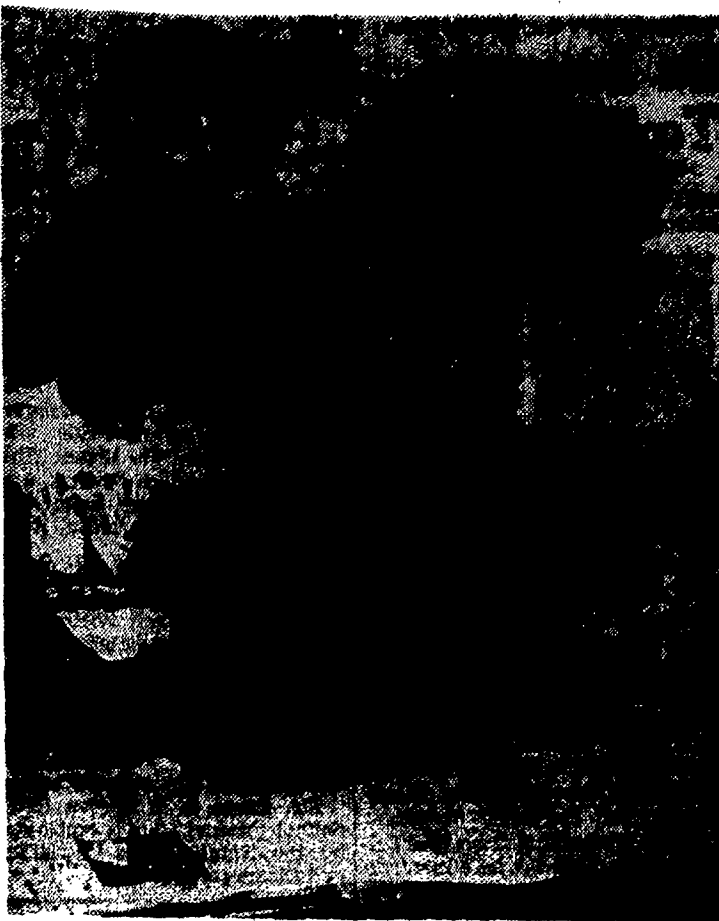
Brothers To Start Mission In Africa

Penn Yan — The various committees of St. Michael's Parish, Penn Yan are working on last-minute details to make their forthcoming three-day Summer Festival a success.

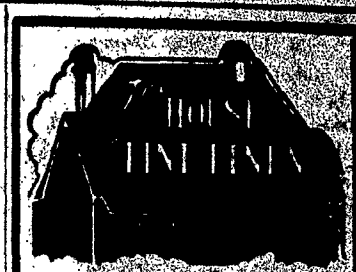
CRAFT WORK COMMENDED

FATHER one day said to his little boy: "If you are not good, your father will not love you." We said to the father: "That is not true! No matter what the boy does you will always love your son. When you son is good you will love him with a love that makes you glad; when your son is bad, you will love him with a love that hurts you. But you can never help loving him."

How often when people hate us for doing wrong, our return to virtue is delayed! How quickly, we seek to return when we know the one whom we hurt loves us still.
