Three-hundred and forty-two Fathers Murphy top all other family names in the priesthood, a check-up by Richard Reid, editor of the New York Catholic weekly The Catholic News, has revealed. Next come the Sullivans with 300. Then the Kellys and the Walshes with 244 each.

COMPARING HIS present survey with a list he made 11 years ago, Reid found that the 12 leaders of 1942, still hold the lead today. But the Kellys have climbed from fifth place to tie the Walshes at third; and the O'Briens (now sixth) have switched with the O'Connors (now seventh).

This year's standings: 342 Fathers Murphy, 300 Sullivans, 244 Kellys, 244 Walshes, 238 Ryans, 221 O'Briens, 216 O'Connors, 206 Smiths, 178 McCarthys, 150 Burkes, 138 Gallaghers and 136 Lynchs.

In 1942 the Murphys led the Sullivans by 13; now they've stretched that lead to 42.

IF YOU'RE WRITING to Father John Murphy, you'd better have the right address, Reid points out. There are 59 Father John Murphys — and 24 of these are John J.

John leads the number of priest's first names all the way down the line, with Joseph in second place.

If some families would get together on spelling, Reid noted, they could rank higher on the list. If 57 O'Sullivans, for instance, would drop that "O," they could combine with 300 Sullivans to lead the Murphys. And 51 Kellys could join 244 Kellys to top them all.

Watch out for those Kellys! — 20,000 At Candlelight Rite Waterbury, Conn. Priests Plan Exploration Trip Through Arctic Area By Canoe

Washington, D. C. (RNS)—The Rev. Arthème A. Dutilly, O.M.I., a biologist at the Catholic University of America here, has started his eighteenth annual exploration of the Canadian Arctic in search of specimens for the university's Arctic Institute.

Catholic University spokesmen said Father Dutilly's research of Arctic specimens also is shared with the Library of Congress' Arctic Institute.

Joining Father Dutilly in his exploration this year is the Rev. Maximilian Duman, professor of biology of St. Vincent College, Latrobe, Pa., and instructor in the summer session at Catholic University. The two botanists will later be joined by the Rev. Ernest LaPage, of the diocesan Agricultural School at Rimouski, Canada.

The explorers will travel by train to a point on the James River, a southern extension of Hudson Bay, and will use a missionary boat to proceed north to the mouth of the Albany River.

There they will pick up their Indian guides and a 20-foot Indian-style canoe which will be their mode of transportation while gathering botanical specimens in the sub-Arctic. Fathers Dutilly and Duman expect to return to the United States late in September.
