(Continued from Page 7) exclusive of the members of the community for whom 32 choir stalls will be provided. The chapel was designed by J. Sanford Shanley, noted liturgical religious vacation schools folarchitect and president of the Liturgical Art Society.

The new chapel has already neceived a number of valuable pieces of rare liturgical art including a French 13th century stone statue of the Madonna and Child, a 14 century triptych painted in Southern France and rare 17th or 18th century wood carving of Christ on the Cross.




