Another, "how can a couple of priests in Hollywood or New York, who probably don't know anything about entertainment or art, tell everyone else what to do?"

WELL, LET ME tell you I am up to my ears in "The Moon Is Blue." I am sick unto nausea. I have spent three columns in the past six months on censorship. I have spent twenty-one inches of type on "The Moon Is Blue" (more than the Legion of Decency did)—and personally I've had it.

The Moon Is Blue has been condemned by the Legion of Decency.
