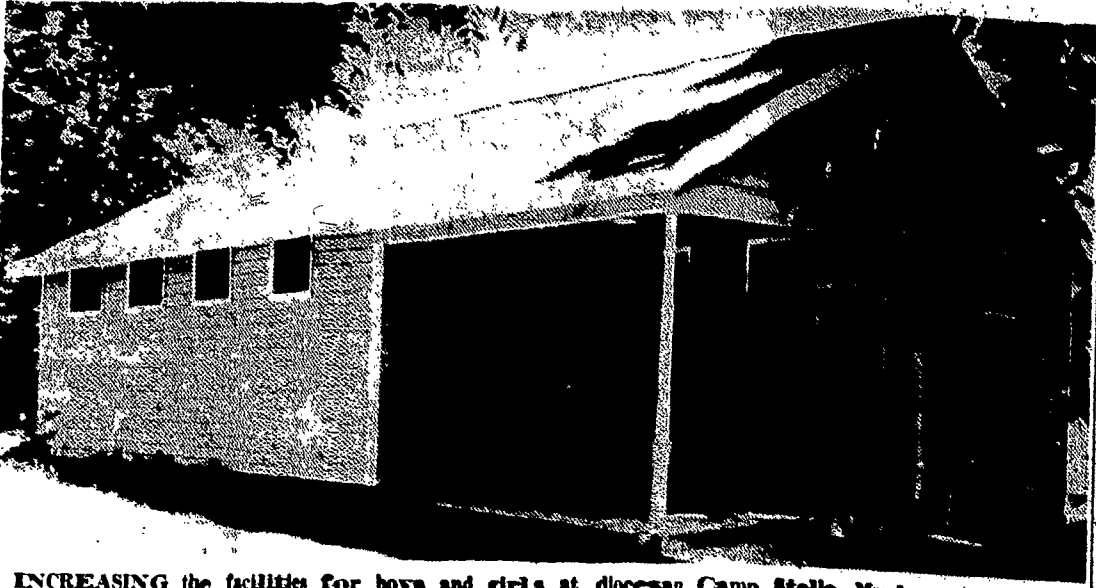


Diocesan Camp Facilities Grow
