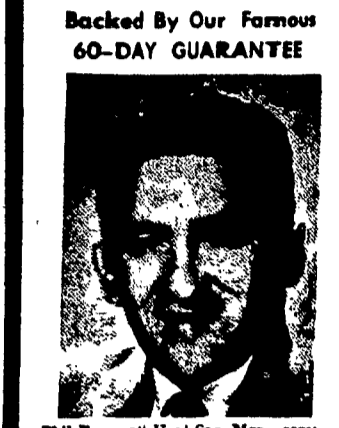


Rummage Sale Scheduled At Court Auburn CDA Meet
