## MIG Pilot's Mother Joins Faith In Korea

Seoul, Korea — (NC)—Inquiry has confirmed Korean press reports that the mother of the North Korean pilot who flew a Russian-built MIG plane from a Red airfield to a United States air base near here is a recent convert to Catholicism.

Her name is Mrs. Ko Jung Wol, a widow. Father John Suh, pastor of the cathedral in Taegu, baptized her on August 13. She took the name Veronica.

Mrs. Ko, who is 43, lives in a refugee camp near the cathedral. She has been going to the cathedral for the past year, praying for her son who was then flying a jet plane of the North Korean Air Force. He is her only child, and his father has been dead about five years.

The mother, who had no previous religious affiliations, now goes to daily Mass and Communion.

These details were provided by Father (Capt.) Nilus F. McAndrew, C.P., United States Army chaplain, who inquired at the Taegu cathedral.
