

New Children's Book Authored By Fr. Brennan

Thirteenth book by the Rev. Gerald T. Brennan, "The children's priest-author" entitled Angel Food Time was released this week by the Bruce Publishing Company of Milwaukee.

The sixth book in his Angel Food Series, Angel Food Time brings 28 more of Father Brennan's simple story lessons that point out the way in which children must know, love and serve God.

With characters like the Boy Who Weighed an Elephant, The Boy Who Dusted the Devil's Tail, the devil who nearly drowned at Coney Island, the witty parish priest makes the stories apply to every day living in lessons that will be remembered.

THE FIRST Father Brennan book came into print 16 years ago after an assistant dared him to have his locally popular children's sermons published. Father Brennan took the challenge and has overwhelmed him with 13 of them. His first book was immediately popular and the stories were used in pulpits and classrooms as practical and effective illustrations in catechism studies.

Today, 16 years, and several thousand stories later, books by Father Brennan are a Catholic byword and his 12 books have sold well over 200,000 copies, some having gone into as many as seven reprints.

THE ENTHUSIASM with which his stories are received is indicated in a recent review of one of his books:

"The value of Father Brennan's clear concise stories has been proven time and again by the hearty reception they receive from children, the direct application in their lives, the retention and pleasurable recall which takes place where Angel Food is used as part of the children's spiritual development." His first book, Angel City was published in 1938. Others following include: Toby's Shadow, The Man Who Never Died, The Ghost of Kingdom Come, The Good Bad Boy, The Man Who Dared a King, God Died at Three O'clock, Angel Food, For Heaven's Sake, Going His Way, Just For Fun, and Angel Food for Jack and Jill.
