Mr. DeRochemont's 'Martin Luther'

The Legion of Decency has placed the film "Martin Luther" in a special classification, one given to certain films which, while not morally offensive, require some analysis as a protection to the uninformed against wrong and false conclusions.

THE FILM is strong, if rabble-rousing ever is strong. Martin Luther is presented not as a very complicated man of varying motivations (which he was) but as a continuous seeker of truth battling his way out of the evils and superstitions allegedly involved in Catholicism.
