Vatican City — (NC) — The Vatican City post office has announced the issue of two special postage stamps to commemorate the eightieth centenary of the death of St. Bernard of Clairvaux, founder of the Cistercians. The stamps, with a face value of 20 and 60 lire, show the famous painting of Filippo Lippi depicting the Blessed Virgin as she appears to the saint while writing. The stamps will be issued November 10. The centenary was marked this year by His Holiness Pope Pius XII in his Encyclical "Doctor Mellifluus."

Denis John Milliken, formerly of Elmira, last Sunday pronounced vows as a member of the Benedictine community of St. Paul's Abbey in Newton, N. J. He received the name Damian and as a cleric will be known as Frater Damian. The young seminarian, son of Mr. and Mrs. Cornelius J. Milliken of 1002 Hoffman St., Elmira, made his profession to the Rt. Rev. Abbot Charles Corison, O.S.B., superior of the Abbey, who celebrated a Pontifical Mass for the occasion. First of simple vows are taken for three years, then renewed for life. They include adherence to the rule of St. Benedict as administered by the Abbot; observance of morals — constant striving for perfection through the practice of poverty and chastity; obedience to the authority of the Abbot. St. Paul's Abbey is a member of the missionary congregation of St. Ottilien whose mother-house is in Bavaria. St. Paul's carries on mission activities in West and South Africa. Frater Damian graduated from St. Patrick's School in 1946 and entered the mission seminary at Newton, conducted by the monks of St. Paul's Abbey for high school students. He began college studies in 1950 and for the past year has been in the novitiate. For the next five years he will continue philosophical and theological studies in the novitiate. The upcoming Sunday were celebrated by Frater Damian's parents, two sisters, Sisters M. Columba, R.N.M., of Merry Hill, Rochester, and Miss Jean M. Milliken, Sister M. George, R.N.M., of St. Cecilia's School.



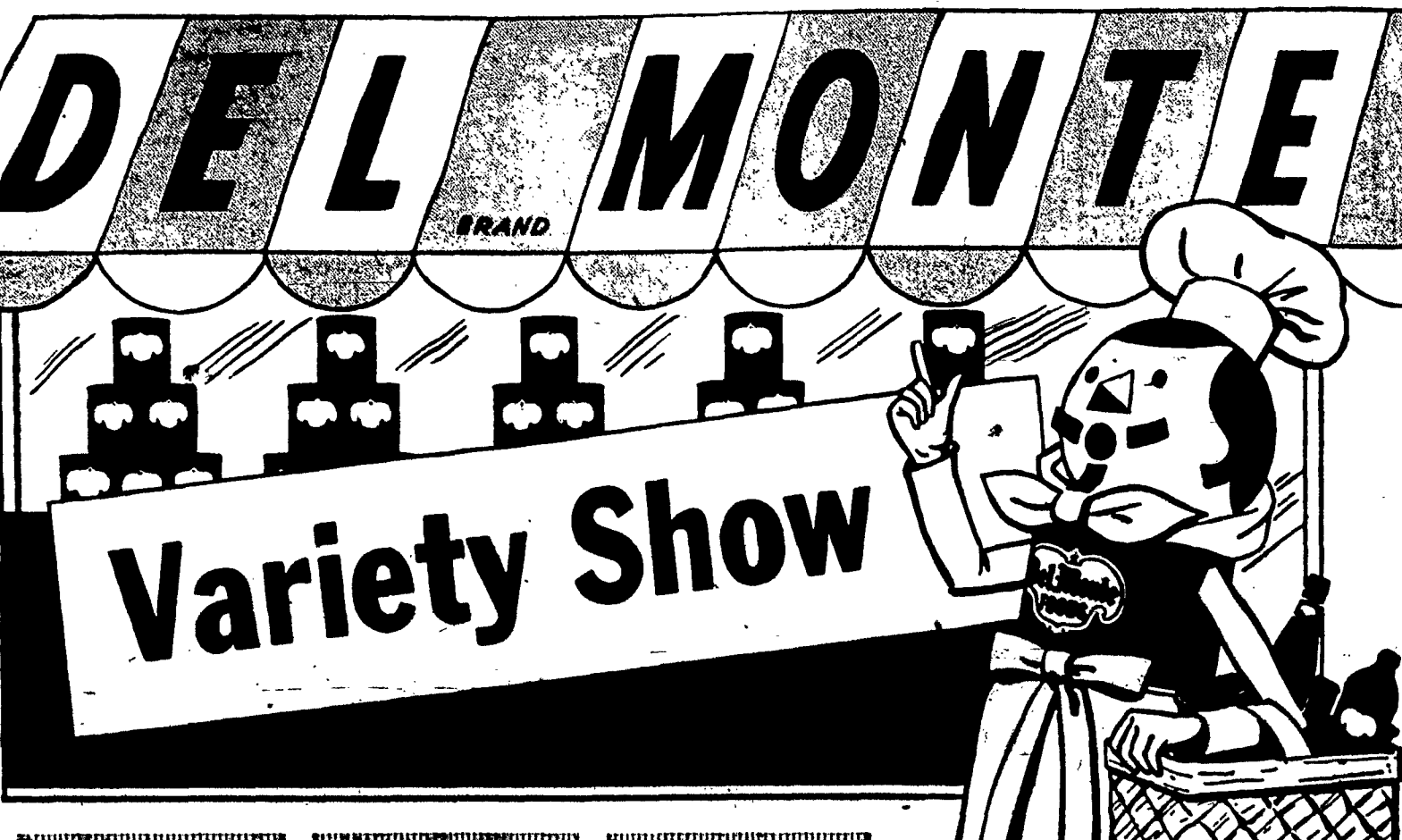

### Australian Catholics Push Immigrant Aid

Sydney, Australia — (NC) — The Australian Federal Catholic Immigration Committee has announced a drive for increased aid for the resettlement of displaced and surplus peoples from abroad. The campaign was initiated in response to an appeal in a Social Justice Statement of the Australian Hierarchy "to think clearly and act courageously on the question of immigration." Strong incentive for the drive was also in appeals from Catholic agencies in Europe confronted with the need of helping thousands of refugees and exiles. Countries likely to be resettled are Holland, Germany, Austria, and Italy, as well as Great Britain. Details of the Catholic Immigration Committee's plan were agreed upon at a meeting here of the Archbishop and Bishops. The practice the plan which is to be known as C.A.R.A. (Catholic Agencies Resettlement Plan) is simply the procuring of promises for accommodations and employment both indispensable prerequisites for the acceptance of overseas settlers. The building, which was used as a hospital for Japanese-Americans during the war, is being converted into a nursing home for the aged. The nuns will be in charge of the facility.
