## Ash Wednesday To Usher In Lenten Rites With Special Speakers, Services Listed

### Evening Mass Permitted At Wednesday Evening Devotions

His Excellency Bishop Kearney has granted permission for celebration of Evening Mass at Wednesday evening Lenten Devotions in all parish churches of the diocese.

The penitential season opening on Ash Wednesday, March 3, will find churches throughout the Diocese of Rochester conducting services, mornings and evenings, as in other years, some scheduling missions and novenas and others arranging afternoon or evening Masses.

In answer to a questionnaire sent out several weeks ago by the Catholic Courier Journal, pastors have submitted their Lenten devotions for publication. Some of these arrived prior to announcement of permission by His Excellency Bishop Kearney for celebration of the Evening Masses on Wednesday evenings. These will be announced from the various pulpits where the Masses will be held.

Lenten devotion schedules in this Marian Year as set into the diocesan newspaper follow:

McAniff; Wednesday, Apr. 7, 7:45 p.m.; Rev. Michael C. Hogan.

Parish Mission to be conducted by Passionist Fathers. Women's Mission opens Sunday, Mar. 21 at 7:45 p.m.; closes Sunday, Mar. 28 at 4 p.m. Men's Mission opens Sunday, March 28, 7:45 p.m.; closes Sunday, Apr. 4 at 4 p.m. Because of the Parish Mission, there will be no Novena of Grace.

Holy Week Retreat to be conducted by a Dominican Father, opens Wednesday, April 14, 7:45 p.m. He will also preach at the Three Hour services on Good Friday, again at evening service. He will preach at all Masses, Easter Sunday.

Pontifical functions during Holy Week follow: Bishop Kearney will pontificate and bless Holy Oils, Holy Thursday, Apr. 15, 10:30 a.m. He will preside at Tenebrae service sung by St. Bernard's Seminary Choir, Holy Thursday, 7:30 p.m. Bishop Kearney will celebrate Mass of Pre-Sanctified at noon Good Friday, Apr. 16. This will constitute first part of the "Three Hour services" at which St. Bernard's Seminary Choir will sing. Bishop Casey will celebrate Pontifical Mass Holy Saturday, Apr. 17 at 8 a.m. Bishop Kearney will celebrate Pontifical Mass Easter Sunday, Apr. 18 at 11 a.m. Music for this Mass will be furnished by St. Bernard's Choir.

Daily Lenten Mass at Cathedral: 6:30 (except Saturdays); 7:00, 7:30, 8:00, and 8:30 a.m.
