

Treasury Hits Narcotic Films As 'Harmful'

Washington-(NC)-Modernizing" the movie Code to permit films on the subject of narcotics, as urged repeatedly by producer Samuel Goldwyn, would not be in the public interest, the U.S. commissioner of narcotics told Commissioner Harry J. Anslinger informed the producer that Spinelli, St. Francis; it is almost impossible to produce pictures dealing with the subject that do not stimulate undue curiosity or interest" in the traffic and use of narcotles "inliting to violations of the narcotc and marijuana laws." Reporting recent gains in comating narcotics, the treasury official said it would be "most un-fortunate . . . if any action such as the showing of motion pictures on narcotics were taken now to endanger those gains." The letter was directed to Mr. Goldwyn after he had stated in wo addresses and one nationwide telecast that he would like to produce a picture on drug adliction but that the subject was forbidden by the Motion Picture

Production Code.


