

### William Coffey Receives Brother Of Mercy Habit

William D. Coffey, son of Mr. and Mrs. Louis J. Coffey of 69 1/2 Locust St. was solemnly invested in the habit of a Brother of Mercy, St. John of God Province, at St. Clare's, N. Y. on March 8.

He will be known in religion as Brother William D. Coffey, F.M. The ceremony was held in the church and was attended by his parents.

The young man, who will be 17 this year, was graduated from Holy Rosary School and attended St. Andrew's Seminary, Rochester for two years.

He has a brother, Bernard Coffey.

Brother Marcellus entered the Brothers of Mercy on August 26, 1953.

These religious brothers furnish male nursing for the sick, feeble-minded and the aged in hospitals and in private homes. In this country the order is located in the Dioceses of Buffalo and of Oklahoma City, and Tulsa, Oklahoma.



The ceremony of Reception will take place at the meeting of the Third Order of St. Francis, Sunday, March 28, at 3:30 p.m. in St. Patrick's Church, 454 Plymouth Ave. North.

Elizabeth Metzger, a Tertiary of Phoenix, Arizona, writes: "A commentary on the rule of the Third Order (in their daily life let them strive to lead others by good example) refers to example as an apostolate. We might keep that in mind, for non-Catholics are very observing of our actions. They are unconsciously trying to learn about the Catholic Church by observing the speech and actions of its members.

### Condemned Convicts Confirmed At Altar Of Penitent Thief

Draper, Utah (NC) — Two condemned criminals, converts to the Catholic Church, were confirmed in Utah State Prison here by Bishop Duane G. Hunt of Salt Lake City.

The "death row" ceremonies took place in a chapel dedicated to St. Dismas, the penitent thief who died on the cross next to Christ. Altar boy at the ceremonies was another prisoner condemned to die.

Announced under the Confirmation names of Matthew and Peter were Melvin LaRoy Sullivan, 25, and Verne Alfred Brown, 24, both sentenced to death for the killing of a service station attendant in 1949 during an attempted robbery.

Bishop Hunt was requested to administer confirmation by prison chaplain, Msgr. Joseph M. Moreton, as time ran out for the pair.

### Veterans Apologize For Branding Film 'Pink'

Red Bank, N. J. (NC) — Catholic War Veterans here who had protested the showing of the film "High Wall" on the grounds that it was "pink" have withdrawn their objection and "regretted" any inconvenience caused by "erroneous" information about the film.

The film was scheduled at a PTA program at the River Street school but was canceled when Leslie C. McBride, past commander of the St. James post 1410 of the Catholic War Veterans and head of a committee to protest the film, asked the PTA not to exhibit it.

Nelson F. Starnler, chairman of the New Jersey Regional Board of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith, on hearing of the action said: "The attack against 'The High Wall,' a film of inner group tensions and prejudice, produced by the ADL in 1952, as 'pink' by a group of films used to teach communism in New York in 1947. He said the film was on the pink list of the Anti-Communist League of New Jersey."
