St. Patrick A Saint Because of Mary, Says Father Gerard

St. Paul, Minn. — (NC) — "St. Patrick is celebrated not so much because he was a preacher, a teacher, and the Apostle of Ireland, but because he was a saint, a man who lives as to merit to die in the friendship and good pleasure of God. All that St. Patrick is today, he owes to his Mother."

The tribute was paid by Abbot Gerard McGinley, O.C.S.O., of the Trappist Monastery at Piffard, N.Y., in speaking to the Ancient Order of Hibernians here.

"We are celebrating today the feast of a great man—who has attained his end, the sight and possession of God," said Father Gerard. He added that "the Fathers of the Church teach that it is the Will of God that we receive all things through Mary."

FATHER GERARD told his listeners that they should be happy to be alive during this Marian Year. He urged them to imitate her charity for God and man, imitate her chastity, imitate her humility, imitate her life of prayer. A man of prayer, like St. Patrick, always walks in the presence of God.

Remembering that many men have changed the course of their lives by their devotion to Mary the Abbot added: "Through prayer to Mary, we can stop the onrush of communism, paganism, Godlessness, and sin; we can obtain the grace that the red flag, the standard of Satan, will never be unfurled over our land. In God we trust."
