By popular demand, the Requiem of Hector Berlioz is to be given a second performance on Saturday evening, May 1, at 8:15 in the Eastman Theater, by the Rochester Oratorio Society.

Over 1,000 persons were unable to obtain tickets for the scheduled performance on April 10, as all seats as well as available standing room had been completely sold out.

J. Theodore Hollenbach will again conduct the chorus, full orchestra, special tympani section, and four brass bands in this seldom-heard work.

Written 133 years ago and performed first in Paris as a memorial to war dead, the Requiem is of particular interest in this sesquicentennial year of the composer's birth.

Tickets to the May 1 performance may be obtained from any member of the chorus or at the Eastman box office.
