

It has been my personal obser vation that children actually behave better when they are most or less hemmed in. If I take a three year old and sit alone with him or her in a front pew, there s a very great temptation for the child either to slide along the polished pew seat, while maintaining a seated position, or to walk precariously on the kneeler. That I would class as disturbing to others in the church because anyone who can see the child shares the fear that he will fall.

I HAVE FOUND that a child viggles less if he is sitting beween two adults or between an adult and an older child; but here again a parent must discover what is best for his own child. I have noticed that many parents put their children on the isle seat. I think this is a help when the child is seated farther back from the altar, because he can stick his little head around the edge of the pew and see the


