

HIS FATHER, the Rev. John Howard Melish, rector of Holy Trinity Church in Brooklyn, was officially removed from his post in 1949 by the Protestant Episcopal Bishop of the Diocese of Long Island for supporting the activities of his son and for maintaining him as assistant rector of the church.
