**Art Head Ousted For Red Flag Use**

Mexico City (NC) — Dr. Andres Buarque, former professor of Spanish at Columbia University, has been dismissed as director of the Mexican National Institute of Fine Arts after he permitted a painter's coffin to be draped with a Soviet flag in the institute rotunda.

Public outcry for Dr. Buarque's dismissal followed funeral observances for the artist-wife of muralist Diego Rivera. In addition to the use of the Soviet flag, newspapers criticized eulogies delivered at the ceremonies as "not so much for the dead artist as in praise of communist ideas."

**Protests Rejected**

**U. S. Approves Iron Curtain Clergy Entry For Attendance At Protestant Parley**

Washington (NC) — The United States government will give permission for 11 delegates from Red-ruled Czechoslovakia and Hungary to enter this country and attend a Protestant world-wide religious convention in Evanston, Ill., in August. An official statement explaining the action took note of "intimidation and persecution of religion" for a number of years by Eastern Europe's red regimes.

**PROTESTS AGAINST** allowing the Iron Curtain churchmen to enter the country had been received by Attorney General Herbert Brownell, Jr., Secretary of State John Foster Dulles, and the Attorney General, taking the position that more good than harm would result from lowering the immigration bars for the Iron Curtain churchmen, approved their entry.

Explaining Mr. Dulles' stand, the State Department issued a statement which said: "It is a well-known fact that for a number of years the Communist-dominated regimes in eastern Europe have been engaged in a campaign of intimidation and persecution against all forms of religion. The purpose of this campaign is to undermine the religious feelings of the peoples of these countries and to make religious groups and religious leaders subservient to the will of the Communist government."

**Protestant Cleric Calls Czech Delegate Red Tool**

Philadelphia (NC) — Dr. Carl McIntyre, president of the International Council of Christian Churches, protested against the entry of 11 Iron Curtain churchmen into the U.S. for the World Council of Churches meeting in Evanston, Ill., on the ground that they will try "to preach propaganda."

Dr. McIntyre particularly was opposed to the admission of Prof. Joseph Hromadka, of Czechoslovakia. He said that the professor, dean of the theological faculty in Prague, had received the medal of the "Order of the Republic" from Antonin Zapotocky, communist president of Czechoslovakia.

"The presentation was made on Hromadka's 65th birthday and in recognition of his merits in the struggle for preservation of world peace," Dr. McIntyre said. "Joseph Hromadka is the No. 1 communist clergy spokesman from behind the Iron Curtain. He is a member of the communist world peace council and has defended Khrushchev's official interests on the situation of Red China in the United Nations, on north Korea, NATO and west Germany. He is entering the country to promote the Red cause in our midst."

**Interdict Lifted In Panama City**

Panama City, Panama (NC) — After a year of silence, church bells were heard here again on the Archbishop lifted an interdict he had imposed after town authorities ignored his order that priests should control celebrations in connection with the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

The order that local authorities protested was aimed at curbing abuses that arose when civic and commercial groups sponsored some of the religious celebrations. Archbishop Francis Beckmann of Panama explained at the time that he did not condemn profane festivities which conform to the general rejoicing and are properly conducted. However, he charged that in many towns, secular festivities have frequently deteriorated into "disgraceful excesses in which alcohol, gambling and lust hold sway."

Assured of obedience in religious matters, the Archbishop lifted the interdict.

**Co-Existence With Reds Impossible, Says Missioner**

Dallas, Tex. (NC) — To admit Red China into the U.N. would be tantamount to rewarding the most diabolical tyranny ever known in history, said Father Valer R. Albers, C.I.C.M. (Scheut Fathers), while visiting here.

FATHER ALBERS, General Delegate for the affairs of the Scheut Fathers in China, was expelled from that country last December as a criminal. He is touring the United States, visiting the many houses of the Scheut Fathers in this country, and asking for prayers that the missionaries be protected and the Faith returned to the Chinese people.

"The Chinese people are 80 per cent anti-Communist, but they can't help bowing reluctantly under their heavy yoke," Father Albers said. "The strongly organized party covers the whole area and has set its disposal a spy ring which strikes half a billion people with terror."

According to Father Albers it is not an exaggeration to estimate that in recent years roughly 15 million Chinese have been killed by their agrarian rulers.

**U. S. Catholic Press Has 20 Million Subscribers**

New York (NC) — More than 20 million people subscribe to Catholic newspapers and magazines published in the United States, the Catholic Press Directory reports.

A total U.S. circulation of 20,701,412 puts Catholic Press circulation at the highest ever recorded, according to the Directory published here this week by the Catholic Press Association.

THE ANNUAL CPA survey covers 377 U.S. Catholic publications and showed an increase of 16 publications and 18 million subscribers for the past year.

The 34 Canadian publications listed in the Directory show a circulation of 1,191,894, bringing the total of Catholic publications in North America to 591, and the circulation to 21,893,306.
