He spoke at the formal installation of the Constituent Assembly which has before it proosals for reform of the constilution submitted by a special om in I ttee for Constitutional studies set up by General Rojas Pinilla following the military coup of June 13, 1953.

The proposal was one of four "urgent reforms" recommended by the government head.
