Bill Walsh, veteran Pittsburgh Steelers center, is getting to be known as one of the old pros in the National Football League.

Walsh will be playing his sixth year in the league this season. He's now working out at the Steelers' training camp at St. Bonaventure University, Olean.

The Steelers are pointing for their charity exhibition game with the Philadelphia Eagles Sept. 1 at Aquinas Stadium, Joe Bach, Pittsburgh coach, particularly is anxious to beat the Eagles, because the Steelers have never beaten the Philadelphia club since Bach began coaching at Pittsburgh two years ago.

Walsh played his college football at Notre Dame where he was an All-American under Coach Frank Leahy. Leahy called him one of the greatest blockers he ever coached.

He played three seasons of single wing at Pittsburgh before the club switched to the T. Walsh has been joined by a more recent Notre Dame star, Johnny Lattner, on the Steelers squad.

Lattner has not started to drill with the Steelers yet, because he is practicing with the College All-Stars who will meet the Detroit Lions Friday, Aug. 13, at Chicago.

The Rev. Daniel O'Rourke, pastor, is honorary chairman with Mrs. Charles Thines and Joseph Mercier, co-chairmen.


Theater Party Slated
