

One of these words is "Catholic." The first document which has survived until our owntime and which contains the expression "Catholic Church" is the letter of St. Ignatius of Antioch to the Church in the city of Smyrna in Asia Minor. It was employed in this letter in exactly the same sense as it is used today, to designate the genuine Church of Christ as something distinct from the various dissendent conventicles which attempted to imitate it.

The word meant "universal," The expression "Catholic Church" meant "the Church that is to be found everywhere."
