Largest Retreat Center Expands

Philadelphia - (RNS)-The si lence that is traditionally associated with a weekend at St. Joseph's in the Hills, the world's largest Catholic men's retreat center at Malvern, was absent on

the Feast of the Assumption. Instead of the usual quota of 300 men for a quiet weekend of prayer and meditation, an estimated 15,000 to 20,000 persons attended the dedication of a new \$800,000 dormitory, chapel and library.

The large tri-unit building is the sixth major addition to the 41-year-old retreat center, located on a secluded, 150-acre wooded tract 30 miles west of here. Named "Our Lady's Hall" as a tribute to the Marian Year, it is regarded as one of the most important milestones in the history of the Catholic Laymen's Weekend Retreat movement. The movement has 22,000 "Men of Malvern" enrolled.
