Largest Retreat Center Expands

Philadelphia — (RNS) — The silence that is traditionally associated with a weekend at St. Joseph's-in-the-Hills, the world's largest Catholic men's retreat center at Malvern, was absent on the Feast of the Assumption. Instead of the usual quota of 300 men for a quiet weekend of prayer and meditation, an estimated 15,000 to 20,000 persons attended the dedication of a new \$300,000 dormitory, chapel and library.

The large triunit building is the sixth major addition to the 41-year-old retreat center, located on a secluded, 150-acre wooded tract 30 miles west of here. Named "Our Lady's Hall" as a tribute to the Marian Year, it is regarded as one of the most important milestones in the history of the Catholic Laymen's Week-end Retreat movement.

Jesuits' Bid For TV Channel Probed By FCC

New Orleans — (NC) — Loyola University has been ordered to outline any "control" the Society of Jesus or the Archdiocese of New Orleans would have over a television station the university has applied for.

A Federal Communications Commission examiner issued the order after station WMOE here, which is also applying for the TV channel, challenged the validity of the Jesuit university's control of the channel.

Father W. Patrick Donnelly, Loyola president, was ordered to set forth "the extent of control, if any, which has been, is now or would be exercised by the Society of Jesus or by the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of New Orleans over Loyola U., its officers or directors, insofar as such control relate in any manner whatsoever to the construction and operation of the proposed television station."

Contestants for the TV channel had originally asked the FCC to investigate the world-wide scope of the Society of Jesus, including its educational and commercial interests, holding that the proposed television station would actually come under the control of the world-wide set-up.

Holy Father Lauds Magsaysay On Faith

Manila, P. I. — (RNS) — Pope Plus XII sent a message to President Ramon Magsaysay of the Philippine Republic praising his "deep Catholic faith" and "admirable Christian piety."

The message was in reply to a greeting sent to the Pope by President Magsaysay on the occasion of the recent canonization of St. Plus X.

Pope Plus said that "the sentiments to which you gave expression touched us and brought us consolation and comfort because they are indicative of deep Catholic faith and of admirable Christian piety."

"We would assure you," he added, "of our thankfulness, and we earnestly ask Almighty God, through the intercession of St. Plus X, to bless your beloved country and to grant it peace and prosperity."

"The Pontiff concluded by imparting "our paternal Apostolic Benediction" on the President, government and people of the Philippines.

Spacing Plan Set For Parish Plants

Little Rock, Ark. — (RNS) — Parish churches and schools in the Catholic diocese of Little Rock are to be spaced at two-mile intervals, so they will be available to all Catholic families in the area.

The plan was announced by Bishop Albert L. Fletcher of Little Rock who said that its purpose is "to give assurance to each Catholic family that they will be within one mile of a parish church or school."

Four building sites already have been purchased by the diocese and other selections are pending.

HIGHLIGHTING A special program of entertainment on the occasion will be the first singing appearance locally of Rochester's Lu Ann Sims since she has risen to fame on the Arthur Godfrey radio and television shows.

Included in the entertainment which will take place on the field before the game in addition to Miss Sims will be several variety vaudeville acts. An appeal for donations from fans in attendance will be made following the added program of entertainment.

IN ANNOUNCING tonight at the Stadium, Mrs. Wehle pointed out that this appeal for extra funds by the National Foundation has been made necessary because of the strain placed on the Foundation's funds by the gamma globulin and vaccine testing programs under which 625,000 American children have been vaccinated with the Salk vaccine this spring.
