

State Probe Bares Over 100 Reds

Hampton, N.H. (NC)—There are 132 persons in New Hampshire who now are or formerly were Communist Party members, it was disclosed by Gov. Hugh Gregg in an address before the Rockingham County Republican Club here.

Governor Gregg asserted that the State anti-subversive investigation, launched by the Attorney General's Department during the past year, had established his administration to lay its finger on those allied with communism.

"We in New Hampshire have quietly, but effectively, gone about this task at the local level and, without fanfare, have gone a long way toward shedding light on communism and tagging those who preach its doctrine," the Governor said.

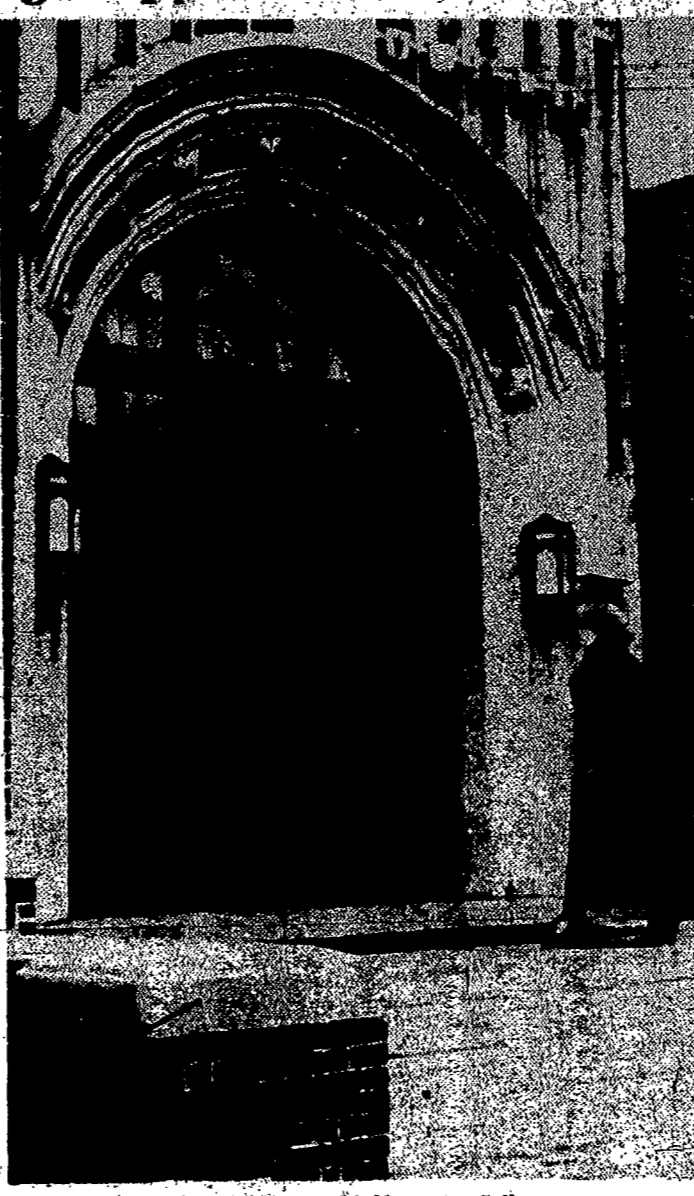

Alleged Apparition Fails To Give Promised 'Sign'

Lisbon, Portugal (NC)—The promised "sign" from an alleged apparition of the Blessed Virgin failed to materialize as some 20,000 people stood by hopefully at a village north of here.

THE "SIGN" had been promised by an 11-year-old boy, Carlos Alberto Silva Delgado, who claims to have seen several apparitions of the Blessed Virgin in the little town of Associa.

The disappointment of the crowd came several days after the chancery office of the Lisbon patriarchate had warned that the reputed apparitions appear to be without foundation. At the same time the chancery forbade all priests to take part in any meetings or gatherings on the spot of the alleged apparitions.

"SENSIBLE PERSONS are advised," the chancery said, "to tell the people in their own circles, that there is the greatest necessity for prudence in cases of this kind and that there is an obligation to stop the spread of credulity which can so easily degenerate into dangerous superstition."
