## Mutual Friendship Society Notes 50 Years Progress

Seneca Falls — The S. M. S. Society, the Society of Mutual Friends, or in English, the Society of Mutual Friendships, will be just 50 years old the first week of November. A fitting celebration and field day has been planned to mark the event.

The organization had its humble beginning in a house in Center St. where a handful of men met for the first time and laid plans to form an organization, just as the name implies, of "Mutual Friends." So strong were the faith and convictions of the small group that many of the laws and By Laws of the Society, written by them, still stand on the books. Only those rendered obsolete by time have been changed.

THE FIRST president to be elected was Armando Salotti. Of the original group of charter members, there are but two left, Natale Barbi and Fred Pederschi, both of whom are still active in the affairs of the society.

During the first few years meetings were held in the homes of the members and later in rented halls on lower Fall St. near the Town Clock. By 1913 the idea was born to build a home of its own. Under the presidency of Remoldo Rossi the plan was adopted. In 1914 under president Emilio Giusti the land on Ovid St., where the present home stands, was purchased. Giusti also drew the plans of the original building, which was erected after a delay caused by World War I.

Under the auspices of president Giuseppe Sorpora, in 1923 the first hall was built, at a cost of about \$60,000 plus the material help of all the members. Shares were sold at a cost of \$5 each to the members to finance the program.

As the society grew, it became apparent that more room was needed and the lodge would have to expand its quarters. The last year of the 30's and the year of World War II forestalled any plans of building. In 1948 under president Peter Giovannetti plans began to take form to remodel the present hall.

In 1950 under Giovannetti the hall was completely remodeled at a cost of approximately \$50,000 by the John Bellardini Construction Co. The new home was dedicated to the memory of the service men of World War II who lost their lives. Lieut. John Sandroni and Fernando Rossetti.

THROUGHOUT the past 50 years the S.M.S. Society has been a mainstay in the village of Seneca Falls. It has grown consistently and thrived as has the village itself. Its members have found their way in every
