New York—(NC)—Bishop Fulton J. Sheen will appear on a nationwide telecast to be carried on 45 stations of the American Broadcasting Company's TV network, 9:30 to 10 p.m., EST., Sunday, October 17.

The program, to be entitled "Mission to the World," will be in preparation for the observance of Mission Sunday, October 24, when a collection for home and foreign missions will be taken up throughout the United States.

Bishop Sheen is national director of the Pontifical Society for the Propagation of the Faith. On the October 17 telecast he will give an explanation of what is happening in the mission areas of the world. The program will originate here.
