

School Chaplain Has Busy Role
St. Agnes Students Provided Classroom Religious Instruction, Counseling by Chaplain

THE REV. JOHN W. LEVEQUE, chaplain of St. Agnes High School, supervised the religious instruction and activities at the new high school. He has fifteen classes each week, instructing freshmen through senior years. In addition to class instruction, Father LeVeque also arranges an individual interview with each student for counseling and guidance.

The Mothers' Club of the school meets monthly under his direction and is presently formulating plans for a more intensive program in keeping with the expanded facilities of the new St. Agnes.

Father LeVeque serves as chaplain to the Sisters of the High School. He celebrates daily Mass in the convent chapel following the school, and conducts Benediction and other church ceremonies for them.

Spiritual care of Catholics detained at Monroe County Penitentiary is also part of Father LeVeque's program.
