Gift For The Spirit

Several years ago I was interested in a friendless old lady living out her days in a county home near a large city. The woman's lot had been a particularly tragic one; she had been a maid in a hotel which years before had been swept by fire.

By the time my attention was called to her, she and her youthful heroism had long been forgotten; indeed, a new generation had grown up who had never heard of the hotel nor its tragic end. It was an employee of the county home who spoke to me about her and said that since I was a Catholic and the woman was also one, perhaps our common religion would help me to make her last days a little more pleasant.

I FOUND THAT all the love which more materially blessed elderly people lavish on their children and grandchildren was poured up inside her and welled out in a great love of God and His Church. Any reminder of her religion, even the simplest holy card, would bring her real happiness. An attendant at the home told me that she kept her little stock of holy cards in the locker which the county provided, where each of its indigent could keep her poor little treasures; and she would pore over each card, studying it as one would the face of a loved relative.

As the Christmas season was approaching I sent word by one of the attendants to find out what, other than religious articles, she would like for Christmas. The message she sent back was: "A can of salmon and a jar of mustard." (I got them for her).

THOSE FEW WORDS have always been for me the symbols of the great tragedy of institutional life. Anyone who has spent for any length of time in an institution, even in the Commissions of a dietetic conscious college, recognizes the monotony of institutional food in that pathetic respect.

If my poor old lady was physically hungry for the smoky tang of salmon and the pungent bite of mustard, how many more people...
