

Boston Television Chapel To Open

BOSTON (RNS)—Archbishop Richard J. Cushing will inaugurate a weekly television chapel here on New Year's day.

The archbishop said the telecast will be a regular Sunday presentation of the Archdiocesan Radio and Television Apostolate under the direction of the Rev. Walter L. Flaherty of Holy Cross Cathedral here.

Construction of the new TV chapel is nearing completion in the Dinosaur Center building on the bank of the Charles River. When completed the chapel will have facilities for color television.

In announcing the new telecast, Archbishop Cushing said it was planned principally for the convenience of shut-ins who are unable to attend church services. He said that a radio broadcast of the Mass heard here every Sunday would continue. The radio broadcast has been made from the archbishop's residence for almost a decade.

Throughout the centuries, shrines have always been a means of showing special honor to Our Lord and His Blessed Mother.
