Describing the magazine's Man of the Year, a feature artile pointed out that in 1954 the world entered an era of legal, if not real, peace for the first time in many years but said "this precarlous peace was paid for at the price of a great betrayal."

With the ceding of northern Vietnam to the Communists it said, 13,000,000 more human beings "disappeared behind the Iron Curtain." Nearly one out of every ten of these were Roman Catholics, making a total of more than 63,500,000 "Captive Catholics under the Communist yoke."

"THE CAPTIVE Catholic," the article continued, "is the purchaser of grace for the nations and the greatest glory of the Church militant. He is a man who follows Christ with a Cross —and little else. He is a man restricted in his access to the Sacraments, when he is not totally deprived of them. He is a man who can teach his child about God only with difficulty and often with grave risk.

"We may see this outstanding man of the year 1954 in a Catholic statesman slowly dying in a Polish prison cell, in a Chinese seminarian struggling through a forced march to a winter labor camp, in a Ukrainian mother teaching the catechism to her child in fearful secrecy, in a starving Vietnamese unable to earn a living because he is a Catholic . . . But in every case, he is a man who has made the greatest choice of his time between God and the world."


