When you're little and the blocks you reach for elude your fingers, it's hard to understand. Other little boys and girls can run and play . . . and when they try to place one block on another, it stays.
But you're different . . . different when you have what they call cerebral palsy.
Then some day, long after your mommy first took you to the nursery school, you pile the blocks up—one, two, three, four high.

Only when you're little can you know how big that makes you feel.
But it does make you feel proud that you, as a contributor to the Community Chest, have played a part in making the accomplishments of these handicapped children possible.
Last year the United Cerebral Palsy Association—one of our 73 Red Feather agencies—gave 4,668 physical, occupational, and speech therapy treatments to 70 child patients; and 3,912 days of care to 35 handicapped children in the nursery school.
