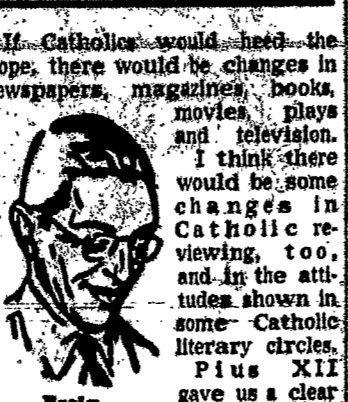
20 Years Of Social Security

JOSEPH BREIG Catholic Literary Circles Rebuked

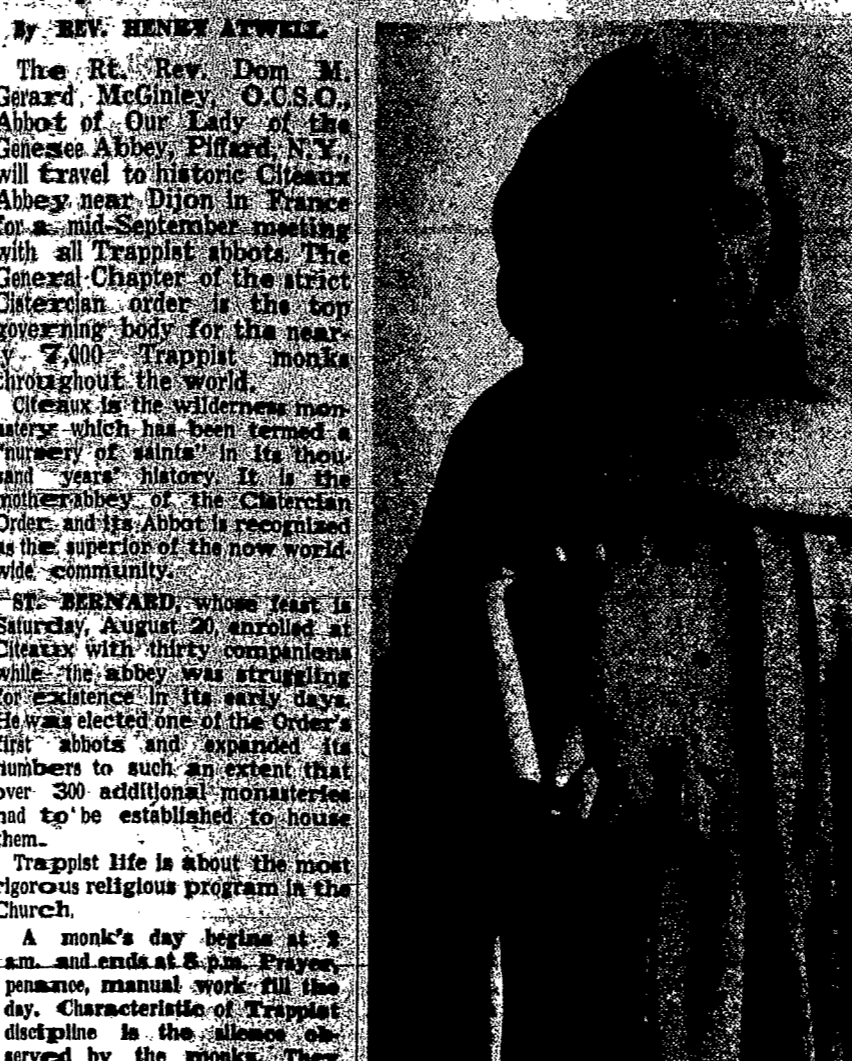
