PLAN WERE made to reorganize the Glee Club within the Fisher Club. Lois Hasenauer will be the director of this project.

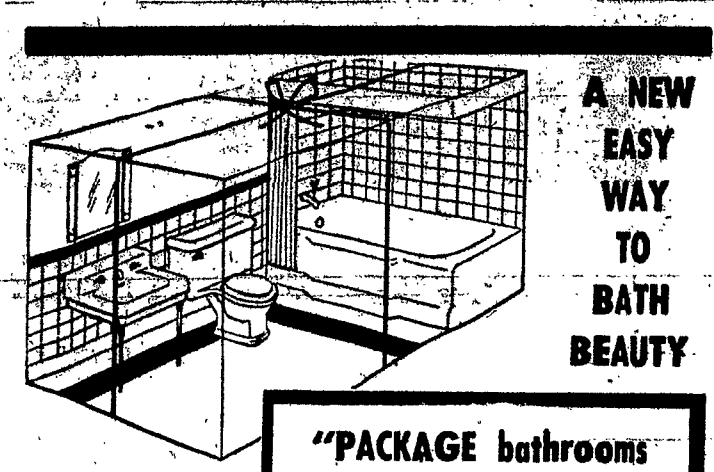
At a business meeting held following the monthly Communion breakfast last Sunday it was decided to initiate a program of speakers from within the club at the monthly Communion breakfasts.
