Notre Dame's Beautiful Air-Conditioned Auditorium Enjoys

Newest Lighting, Acoustical Facilities, Accommodates 1,000

THE MOST MODERN and beautiful auditorium in the entire Southern Tier is one of the outstanding highlights of the new Notre Dame High School.

Completely air-conditioned, styled for beauty, comfort and wide usage, the new auditorium will be the setting for many Elmira civic and parochial gatherings as well as school activities. Designed with the latest in lighting facilities, sound-engineering for acoustical perfection and fitted with stage equipment rarely found in even commercial theaters, the auditorium will be used for general assemblies, concerts, religious services, and annual dramatic offerings produced by the student body.

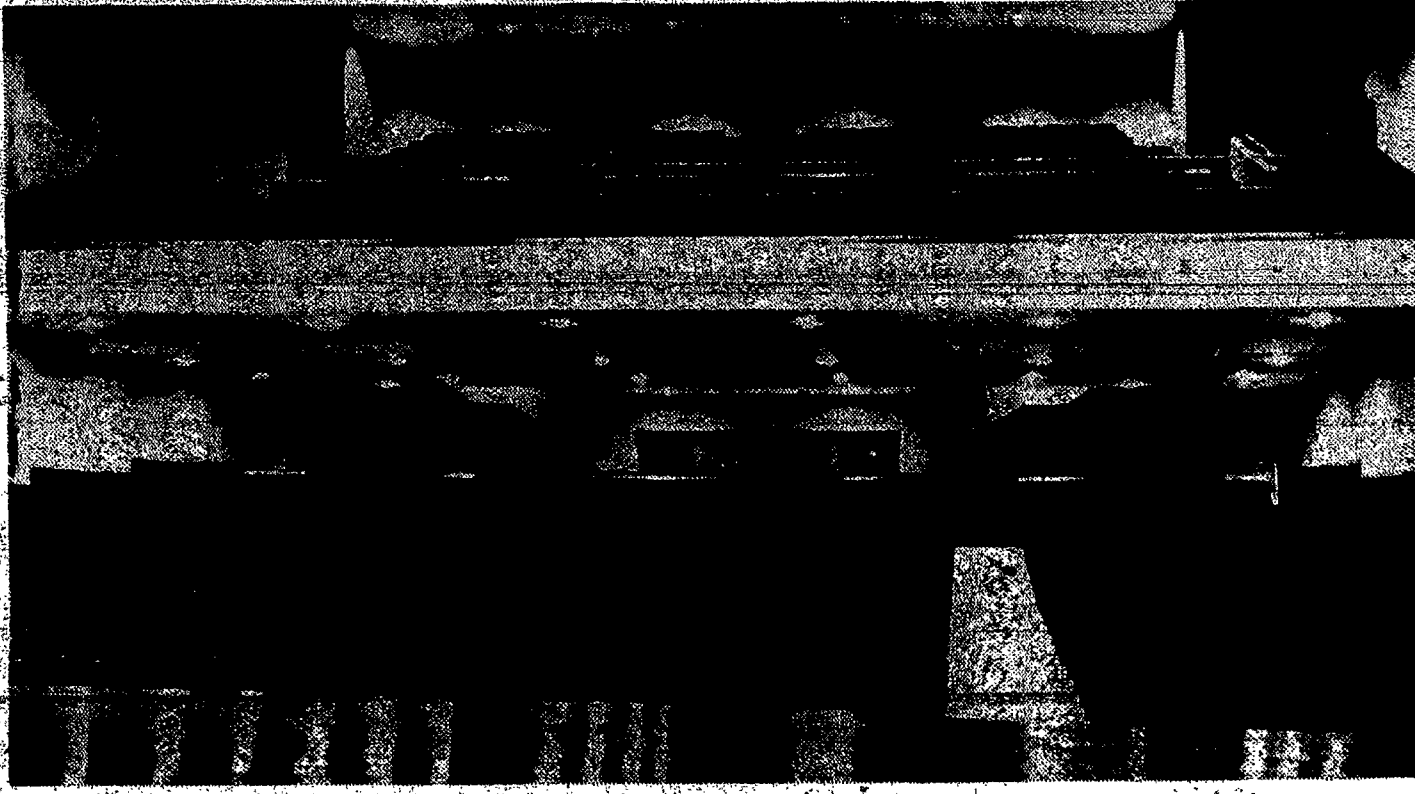
The auditorium with main floor and balcony, will accommodate 1,000 people. The seats are done in royal blue mohair and the carpeting for the aisles, orchestra pit and transeways is rose beige with rubber-cushioned underside.

Wine-colored johanna cloth lines the lower sections of the side walls. The acoustical plaster in the upper walls is rose-tinted blending with an orchid shade used on the rear walls.

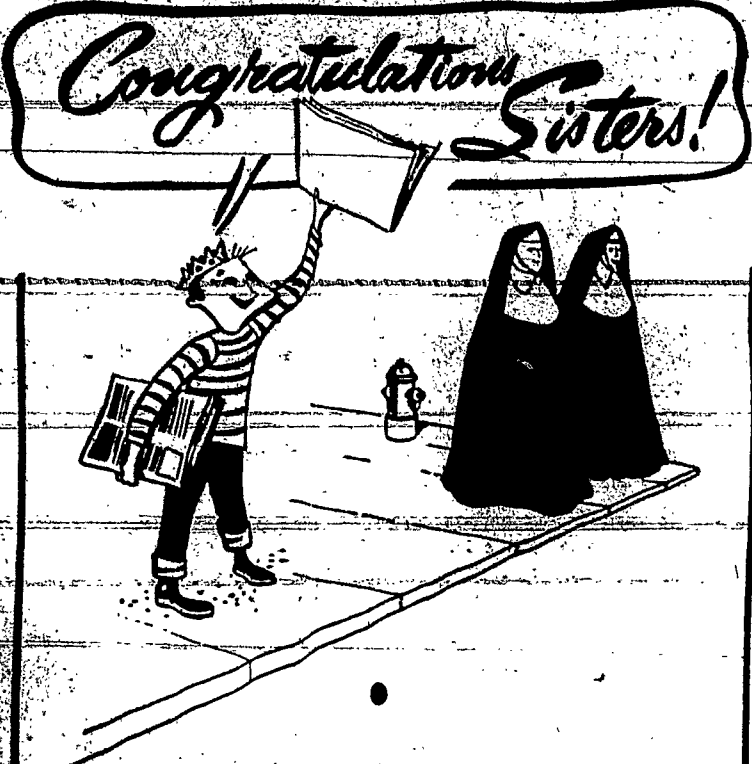
Lighting throughout the auditorium is recessed and fluorescent providing a soft indirect glow to enhance the color effect of the seat materials and the tinted walls.

AN EYE-CATCHING item in the decorative scheme is the blue and white seal of the school displayed over the exit doors near the orchestra section. The school motto, "Ego Sum Lux Mundi" (I am the Light of the world) rings the circular school emblem.

duction, is equipped with a blue velour curtain and a gleaming gold grand drape. Intricate lines and pulleys control thirty-two sets of rigging for stage drops, curtains and set-pieces. Borders of overhead lights, footlights, baby spots and arc lamps to provide dramatic variety of lighting for every auditorium event are controlled from the latest type stage-switchboard.

The rear wall of the stage has a large sliding door opening directly outdoors providing easy movement of bulky scenery and stage equipment. Dressing rooms, makeup rooms and wardrobe closets are below the stage.

In the orchestra pit at the right corner of the stage, there is a Baldwin organ to be used in the school's musical programs and concerts as well as for religious services held in the auditorium.
