Notre Dame Enrolls 341

The new educational Notre Dame High School threw open its doors to 341 students of Elmira and area on September 7th. The need for such a school in the Southern Tier is demonstrated by the distance students are willing to travel in order to attend Notre Dame, Corning, Waverly, Horseheads, Athens, and Sayre. Pennsylvania are represented in the present student body.

Students from all Elmira city parishes are in attendance. These include: St. Patrick's, St. Mary's, St. Cecilia's, St. Casimir's, St. Peter and Paul's, St. Anthony's, St. John's, and Our Lady of Lourdes, as well as St. Charles in Elmira Heights and St. Mary's in Horseheads.

The registration statistics are as follows: Total Registration: 341. Freshmen - 120 (boys, 55; girls, 65). Sophomores - 103 (boys, 48; girls, 55). Juniors - 72 (boys, 26; girls, 46). Seniors - 46 (boys, 16; girls, 30).
