

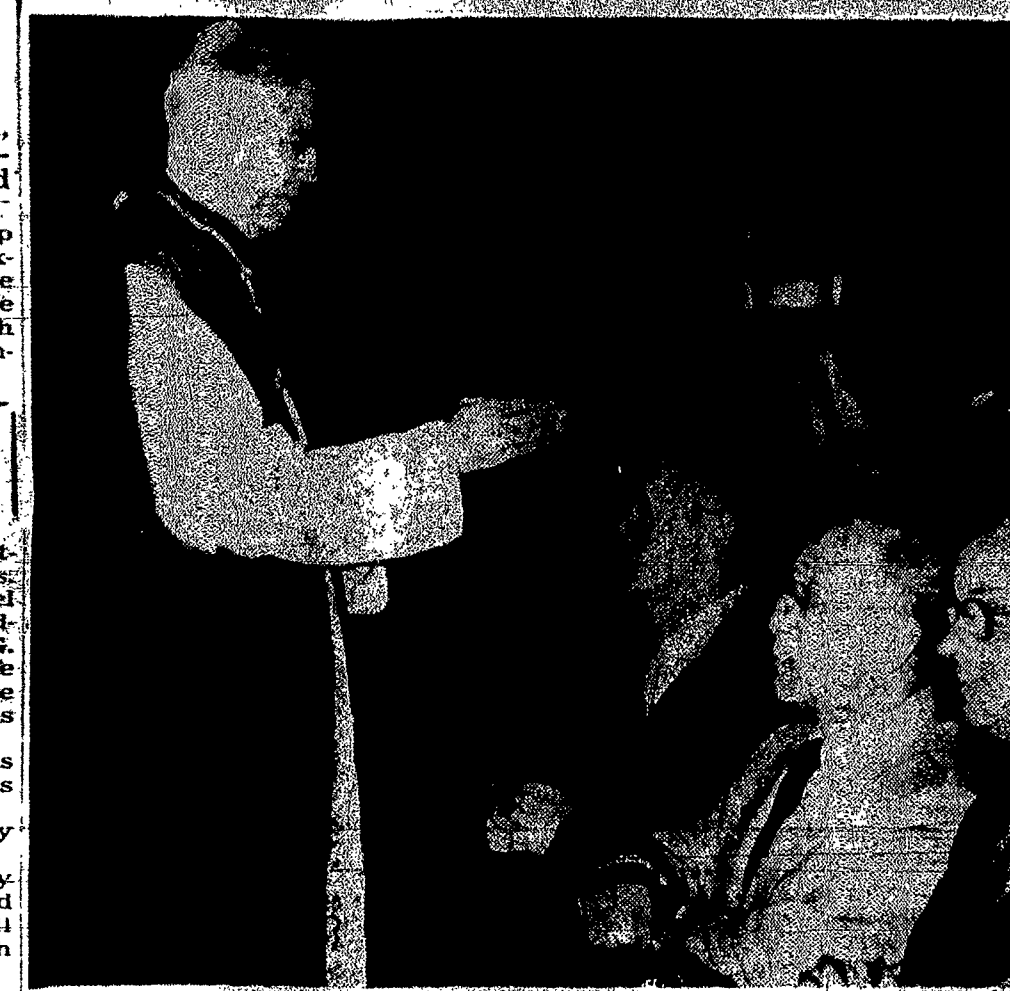
### DeSales High Class Of 1930 Holds Reunion
