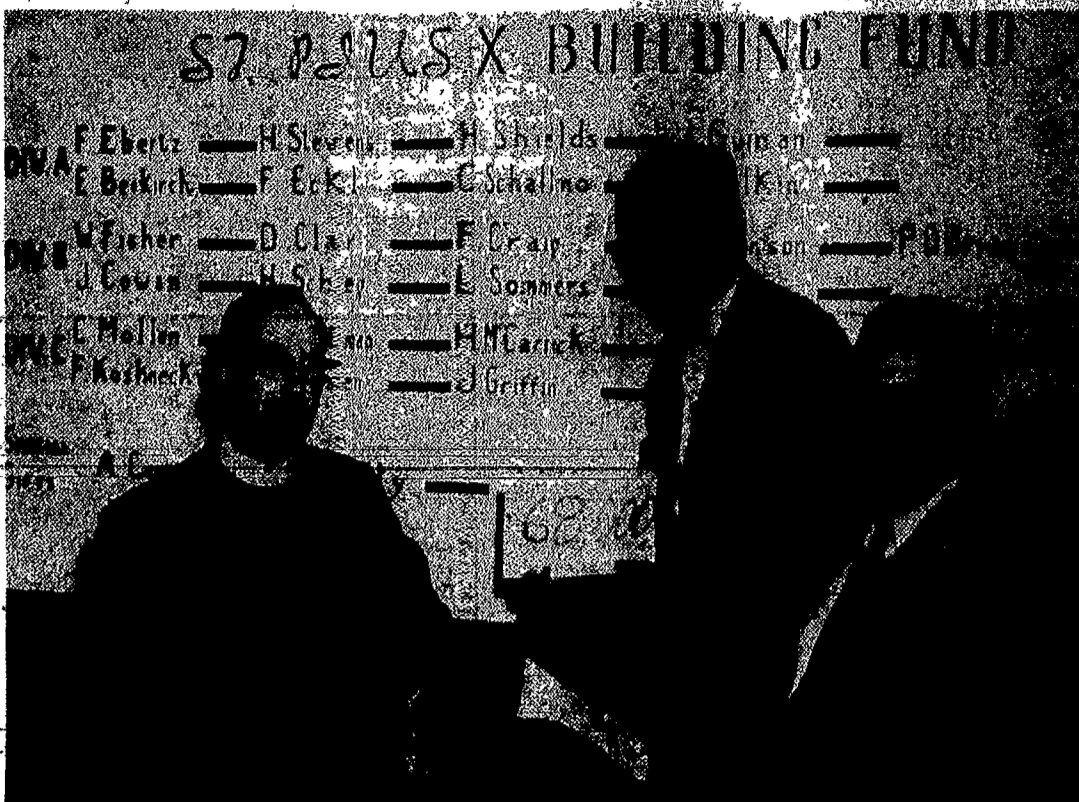


St. Elizabeth Guild Plans Card Party

Bishop To Speak \$70,000 Mark Eyed To Fairport Club In St. Pius X Appeal

His Excellency Bishop Kearney will inaugurate the First Friday Supper Club of St. John Fisher Council, Knights of Columbus by speaking at the first meeting in Assumption Hall, Fairport at 6:30 p.m., Nov. 4.

St. John Fisher Council comprises knights residing in Fairport, East Rochester and surrounding areas.

Bishop Kearney inaugurated the First Friday Luncheon Club sponsored by Rochester Council in December, 1942 which will be completing its 13th year today at Sheraton Hotel, Rochester.

A total of \$67,892 pledged and the expectation that when all returns are in that the sum may reach \$70,000 were announced at a dinner attended by more than 100 workers and climaxing the Appeal of the new St. Pius X parish.
