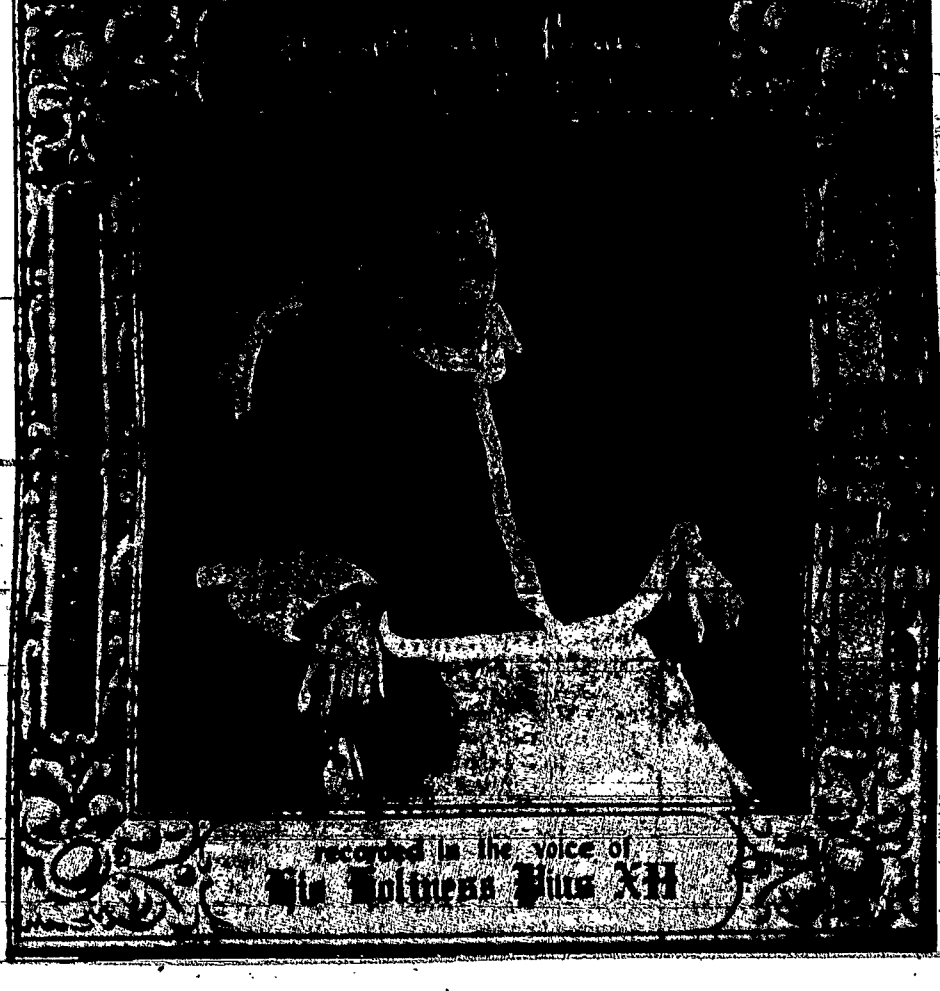
Various items of food and merchandise will be on sale. Super tickets are 75 cents for adults and 40 cents for children.

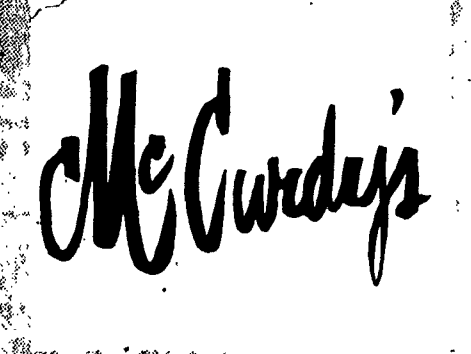
