Rochester Missionary Arrives At Gold Coast

Development of teacher training facilities for girls and the native Sisterhood received new impetus at Accra, the capital of the Gold Coast, with the arrival of Sister Pierre Fischeit, S.S.P.S. of Rochester, and Sister Gerard Smith, S.S.P.S. of Chicago, on Nov. 2.

The two Holy Ghost Missionary Sisters who sailed from New York on Oct. 7 aboard the S.S. African Dawn were welcomed by the students of St. Mary's Secondary School and the Holy and Drums Corps of St. Mary's Middle School, Accra.

Sister Pierre Fischeit, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Rocco Fischeit, of Rochester, and a graduate of Nazareth College, will immediately take up duties as instructor in St. Mary's Secondary School (equivalent of senior high school and junior college) in Accra, the capital of the Gold Coast.

Before her appointment to Accra in May of this year, Sister Pierre, until forced to leave by the Communists, was instructor in the Women's College of the Catholic University of Peking, China.

After fleeing to the Philippines, Sister Pierre was professor of English at Holy Ghost College of the Holy Ghost Missionary Sisters in Manila. At the same time she trained, aided, and supervised the extensive catechetical and social work carried on by the Holy Ghost College students in the public schools and slums of Manila. Nehru Condemns Attack On Church

Tuticorin, India — (NC) — Indian Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru expressed regret at the desecration last month of the Catholic church at Vardman Nagar in the Diocese of Patna.

In a reply to representatives of the Catholic Union here, the Prime Minister condemned the incident as "despicable, scandalous and deserving of heavy punishment." He said the report pained him greatly.

Mr. Nehru declared that the state government has asked for a report on the invasion of the church by a group of fanatic Hindus. "The men who attacked a priest while he was saying Mass and then kept the priest and other missionaries prisoners for an hour. They stole the sacred vessels and scattered the Blessed Sacrament around the sanctuary."
