San Rafael, Calif.—(RNS)—Prayers that supplicate the Deity were ruled out of Marin County schools following a complaint by James H. Newby, who said his son Carl, 5, was dismissed from kindergarten when he objected to saying grace.

Mr. Newby said that if he wished to have his children instructed in religion he would have sent them to a church school. He then took his son out of the school.

The issue involved a versified grace offering thanks to God, which was recited by the children before each snack time.

Clifton L. Boyle, superintendent of schools, said a new grace has been adopted which makes no mention of God.

"The price is right," the missionaries agreed, "and we're never short for newsboys."

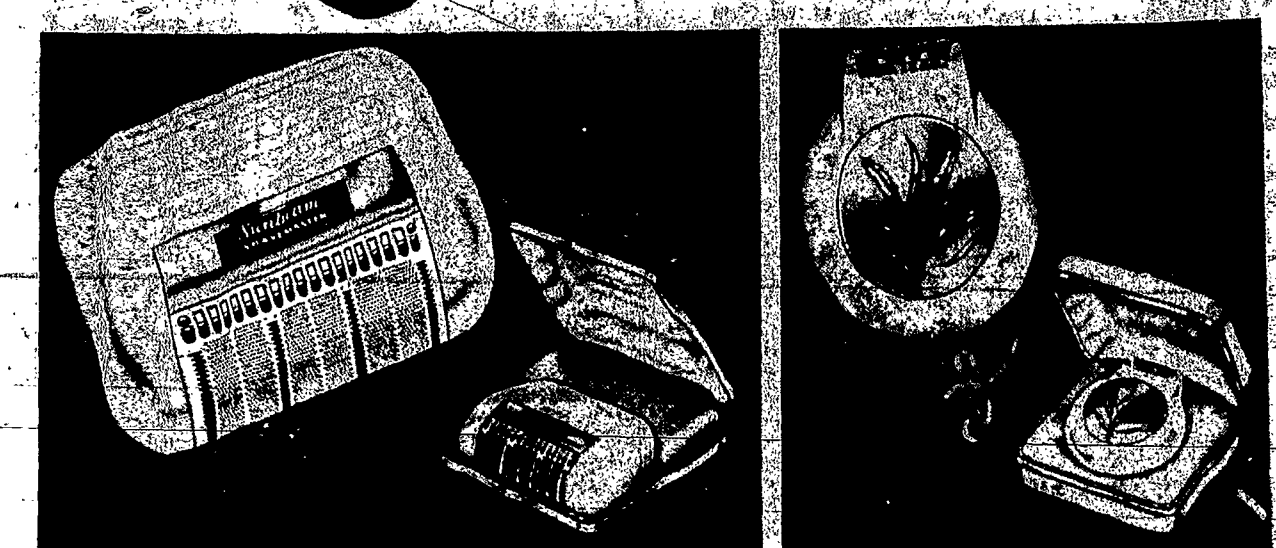
