Dictator Nikita Khrushchev has pulled out an old bag of tricks and put new labels on it. By "coalition governments," the Communists were enabled to fascinate their dictatorial regimes over Poland, Hungary, Bulgaria, Rumania and the Balkans. Under the guise of "coalition governments," the Communists staged huge and violent demonstrations against the very governments of which they were supposedly a part. This led to the overthrow of those governments.

By his talk of relying on parliamentary means in certain countries, Khrushchev is preparing the way for entangling forces in France and Italy to work with the Communists in a coalition. If that were to take place, it would bring about the same disasters in those countries as previously occurred in the nations behind the iron curtain.

THE SOVIET dictator is also preparing the ground for his fifth column in every country to claim that it stands for parliamentary, that is "peaceful," means of taking over the government. Moscow hopes that this will throw dust in the eyes of the American people, for ex-comrades, by "non-aggression pacts" and "coalition governments," a contribution to peace.

Exiles Plan Protest On Red Visitors

London — (NC) — Catholic exiles from the world behind the Iron Curtain are organizing a mass rally at London's Albert Hall on Sunday, March 25, to protest against the proposed visit to Britain in April of Marshal Nicolai Bulganin and Nikita S. Khrushchev, top Soviet leaders.

POLISH GROUPS here are drawing up a petition to be signed at the meeting asking the British government to seek truly free elections in Poland, freedom of religion, and liberation of prisoners still held in Soviet slave camps. They also are preparing a leaflet to be distributed in plants, stores and offices throughout the country.

Requiem Masses will probably be offered in Polish parishes in Britain during the Bulganin-Khrushchev visit for the anniversary of the massacre of thousands of Polish officers in the Katyn Forest during World War II.

No official Catholic demonstration is expected when the Russians come to Britain to be honored with all the ceremony of a state visit. But special prayers may be asked for the persecuted Church behind the Iron Curtain and for the conversion of Russia.

Milan Prelate Cites Red Gains In Italy

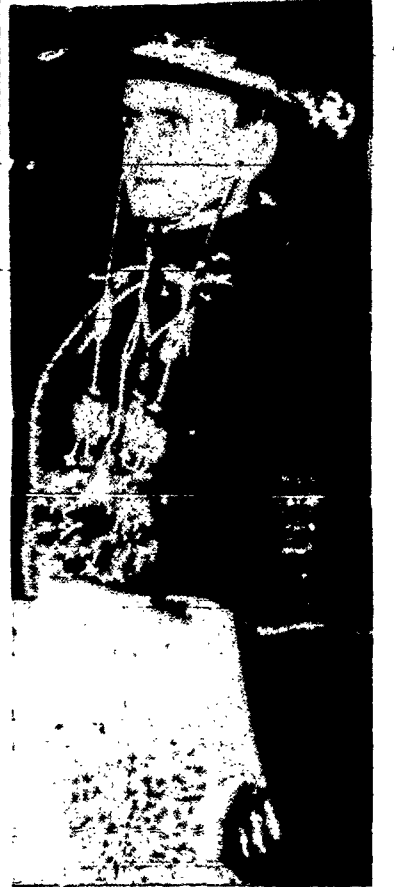
Milan, Italy — (NC) — The growing threat of communism in Italy has been emphasized by Archbishop Giovanni B. Montini of Milan in his Lenten pastoral letter. Communism is making progress in this country, the archbishop said, despite the fact that it is "contrary to our history, our beliefs, our culture, our needs and our interests."

IT MIGHT HAVE been thought at one time, he continued, that communism was a passing post-war phenomenon destined to fade away with the restoration of peace and public order. Instead, he stated, it has had an alarming spread in Italy, where there are more communists than in any other country outside the Iron Curtain.

Communism has penetrated every locality, engaged in every form of activity and disturbed every social class, the archbishop noted. Two factors are responsible for the increasing Red threat, he said. They are communist organization and propaganda.

"Unfortunately it has found an ideological and social turmoil in which it thrives in the unstable cultural and civic climate of our country," he said. "In its individualistic and rebellious temperament, in its native instinct for opposition to the laws of the community, in the too easy homage which our mentality gives to foreign formulas and in the irresponsible puritanism of some men who are always ready to recognize good in an enemy and error in a friend."

ARCHBISHOP Montini warned Catholics not to be deceived by the friendly overtures of communists. They will show charity, tolerance, he said, as long as they can increase their numbers. He urged Catholics to be vigilant and to recognize whoever deals with it.

But their victims will find out too late, he added, how this pretended charity becomes hatred. "Every compromise of atheistic communism," he said, "hides a secret plan to disarm and subjugate whoever deals with it."

Radio To Instruct Indians in Bolivia

Penas, Bolivia — (NC) — Two American missionaries will launch a radio apostolate to give religious instructions to thousands of Indians scattered over the Andean plateau. The plateau, located in western Bolivia, has an average altitude of 12,000 feet above sea level. The missionaries are completing details for their network which will be inaugurated on March 24. It will include a radio station and centralized receiving sets where the Indians will receive instructions.

Visiting the outstations in this remote area is a difficult task. The inhabitants have been baptized but have not been instructed in the fundamentals of the faith because of a lack of priests.

Hospitals' Blood Program Shows Unity Of Humanity

Worcester, Mass. — (NC) — "The blood program in any large hospital makes a point of which we cannot be too frequently reminded," Bishop John J. Wright of Worcester declared here.

"Nothing more dramatically reveals the unity of the human family as God made us from the beginning," he said, "than the manner in which human blood, whoever gives it, mingles with the blood of other humans to save their lives."

"BLOOD is donated by people of all races, nationalities and groups. It is given, without distinction or discrimination, to the person who needs it, no matter what his race, creed or color."

Bishop Wright spoke in announcing the reorganization of the blood bank board at St. Vincent Hospital. The new chairman of the board is Wesley E. Melquist, a non-Catholic.

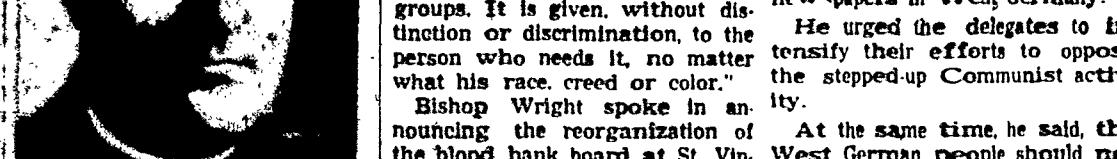
Reds Infiltrate West Germany

Cologne, Germany — (NC) — Communists have increased their subversive activities in the industrial plants of West Germany, a German official said here.

Fred Sagner, chairman of the Ministry for all-German questions, told Catholic workers in Cologne that 200 Red agents are sent each month to work in industrial plants and on plant newspapers in West Germany.

He urged the delegates to intensify their efforts to oppose the stepped-up Communist activity.
