**120 Parishes Report C-J Total Coverage**

More than 100 of the 146 parishes of the Rochester Diocese reported results of February's circulation campaign to the Courier-Journal office, according to Elmer Grapenstetter, circulation manager.

Current subscriptions to the Courier-Journal expire with the March 30 issue. New subscriptions will begin on April 6, Mr. Grapenstetter stated.

Rev. Francis Pegnam, pastor of St. Thomas More parish, Rochester, has adopted the "total coverage" plan for the first time this year with a total of 240 subscriptions.

This brings to 120 the number of parishes having all families enrolled as subscribers to the Courier-Journal.

Rev. William Ayers, pastor of St. Vincent de Paul Church, Churchville, in renewing total coverage for this parish reports twice as many subscriptions as last year, increasing from 51 to 108.

Rochester parishes renewing the 100 per cent program as reported this week are: Holy Apostles, Rt. Rev. Msgr. George V. Prémontre, pastor, 638 subscriptions; St. Peter and Paul, Rev. Robert J. Fox, 743; and Our Lady of Victory, Rev. Edward P. Callens, 33.

**Auxiliary Named In Harrisburg**  
Washington — (NC) — Msgr. Lawrence F. Schott, pastor of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church, Pa., has been named by Pope Pius XII to be Titular Bishop of Eliza and Auxiliary to Bishop George Leach of Harrisburg.

The appointment was announced here by His Excellency Archbishop Amleto Giovanni Cicognani, Apostolic Delegate to the United States.

Bishop-elect Schott was born in Philadelphia on July 26, 1907, the son of Thomas and Emma (Holer) Schott. His mother resides in Danville, Pa. His father is deceased.

**Lent Church-Goers Ride Buses Free**  
Buffalo, N. Y. — (NC) — Church-goers here are riding buses free when going to and from church on Sunday mornings during Lent.

For the fifth consecutive year the Niagara Frontier Transit System, which serves the entire city and some suburban areas, has made its free-rides offer between the hours of 5 a.m. and 2 p.m. Anyone who informs the bus operator he is going to or from church saves a 20-cent token.

Roswell F. Thoma, president of the transit company, said the free rides are given worshippers "in recognition of the fact that our churches are custodians of the great spiritual truths on which our civilization has been built and because they stand for the enduring values in our western way of life."

Auxiliary Bishop Leo R. Smith of the Buffalo Roman Catholic diocese said the bus company is "pointing out the remedy for all the evils in the community, the nation and the world — the observance of the Ten Commandments."
