Cayuga Retreat League Hears Father Jamison

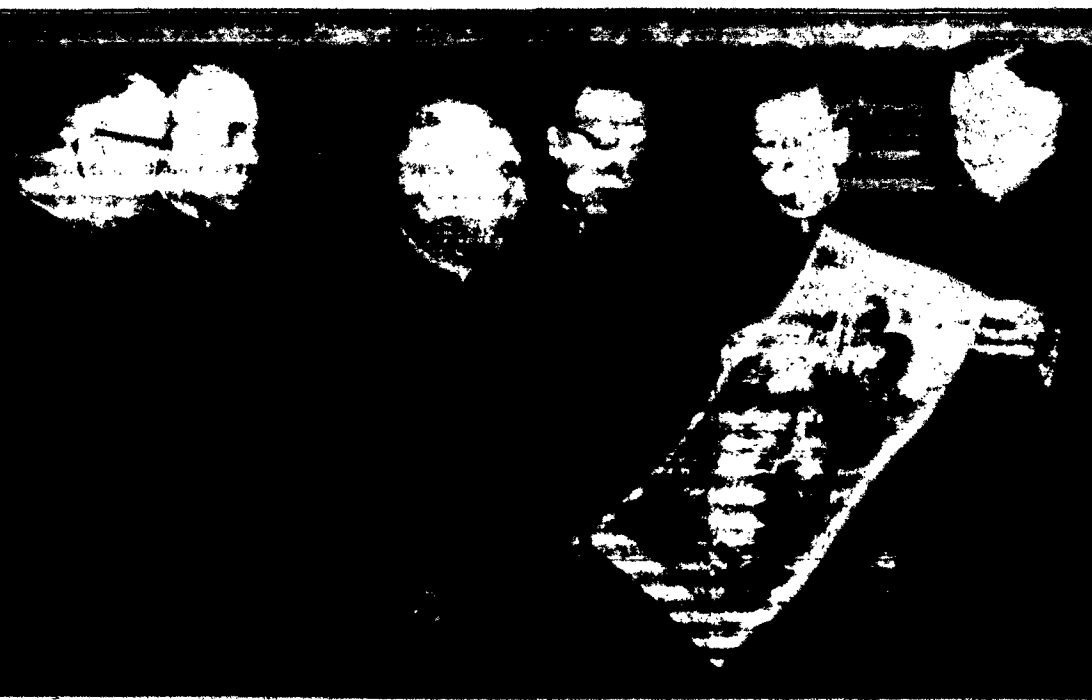

Geneva Nurses Offer Three Year Scholarship

Geneva Unit of the National Council of Catholic Nurses sponsors a full three-year scholarship in either the School of Nursing of St. Mary Hospital, Rochester, or St. Joseph Hospital, Elmira.
