## SECURITY REPORTS DUE IN APRIL

Social Security reports are due in April from taxpayers in the Rochester area who employ domestic workers, according to B. L. Keenan, director of the Rochester district office of Social Security Administration. Housewives are required to make these reports during April on those food workers paid as much as \$4 in last wages in January, February and March. This is the fifth quarterly report due since the new law covered household employees without regard to the number of days worked. Reports are sent to the District Director of Internal Revenue at Buffalo, New York.

Winners were selected from 2892 applicants from all parts of continental United States, Alaska, Hawaii and Puerto Rico. 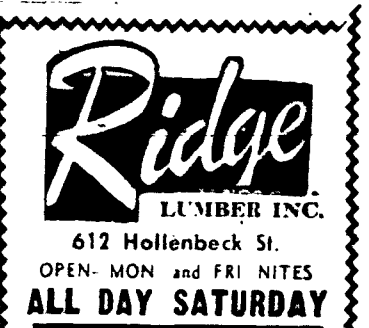
