## Good Friday Closing Move Gains In Stores, Factories

Machines will stand idle, counters will be covered with dust sheets and typewriters silent in many factories, offices and stores of the Rochester Diocese on this Good Friday. Many concerns are closing for Three Hours, to enable employees to attend their churches for the Good Friday services. With the new changes in the Holy Week liturgy, the faithful will now be able to receive Holy Communion on Good Friday. **KNIGHTS OF COLCUBUS** in the diocese have inaugurated a movement every Lent since 1948 requesting business firms to close for at least a portion of Good Friday. Nearly 400 concerns are expected to close this year. They have also appealed for the cooperation of parochial and high schools. Children are urged to call the matter to the attention of parents so that shopping will be discontinued during the Three Hours. Children themselves have been requested to refrain from attend-

Solemn liturgical services in compliance with the directive of His Holiness, Pope Pius XII in December, 1955, will be conducted in the Diocese of Rochester during Holy Week. His Excellency Bishop Kearney and His Excellency, Auxiliary Bishop Casey will officiate at services designated at new times in accordance with the Pope's directive.

Services will be conducted in commemoration of the Passion and Death of the Redeemer in Sacred Heart Cathedral and other churches and chapels of the diocese.
