**750 Legionaries Hear Bp. Kearney At Actes**  
 His Excellency Bishop Kearney addressed approximately 750 active and auxiliary members of the Legion of Mary at their annual Actes meeting in Corpus Christi Church on Sunday, March 23.

"Don't sit there, do some thing" was his way of summing up the definition of devotion to the Blessed Mother and also the aim of the Legion. He quoted the Holy Father that devotion to our Blessed Lady can never be a selfish thing, that it cannot reveal in satisfaction peace and contentment, that it must involve working for souls as Mary worked for them in sharing the work of redemption with her Son.

Bishop Kearney commended legionaries for meeting annually to renew their acts of consecration, thus strengthening them selves for the aggressive form of Catholic action which is the legion's work.

He expressed deep gratitude to legionaries who are helping "shepherd the sheep of his flock" by taking his pastoral staff and going down into the minds and hearts of the people.

The Mass, at 11 is to be celebrated in the chapel of St. John the Evangelist on the university campus. It will be preceded by a procession at 10:40.

Father Plassman, a former president of the university and one-time provincial-general of the Order of Franciscans Minor, is now rector of Christ the King Seminary. He holds the degrees of doctor of philosophy and doctor of literature.

Following the Mass of Thanksgiving, he will be honored at a dinner in the Alexander Hickey Memorial dining hall at the university.

**11th Annual Fishing Contest Opens, \$1,000 Offered For New Style Fishhook**

Two hundred and forty four anglers will walleyed pike, muskellunge, perch, pickerel, rock bass, brook trout, brown trout, rainbow trout and lake trout. Fish must be taken in legal open season, on the rod, reel and line, in New York State waters by legal residents of New York State. At the end of the seven month contest period, grand prizes will be awarded to each classification during the anglers who enter the largest year.

Complete details of the contest with lists of previous winners, is contained in an interesting 28 page Fishing Guide published by Mr. Wehle and distributed without charge by stores throughout the State.

In addition to the annual contests conducted in the interest of better fishing and greater conservation, Wehle is this year offering a \$1,000 reward for a fishhook. "A high percentage of fish are caught and released are permanently injured by the hook and die as a result," says the Rochester sportsman and conservationist. "Someone has the answer to this problem and I will reward this person with \$1,000 in cash for designing—(1) a hook, the removal of which will not injure the fish, or (2) a hook which will harmlessly dissolve in a reasonable length of time if left in the fish, or (3) any feasible solution to the problem." Ideas, designs, drawings or models should be submitted before Jan. 1, 1937 to Wehle at 100 National St. Rochester 5, N. Y.
